



2024 Christmas Ride



Join us for a scenic camping trip and trail ride in Joshua tree national park.

Black rock equestrian campground is located at 4,000 ft elevation. There are multiple loop trails. Trails are well marked and vary in degree of difficulty from easy to difficult.

Camps include picnic tables and fire rings, and are unmarked. There is 1 spigot for horse water, and manure disposal. Bathrooms are a short hike from the horse camp. Bring manure carts, as both water and manure disposal are a bit of a jaunt. Limited corrals are first come first served. Tying to trailers, portable corrals and high lining are allowed. We will have a potluck dinner Saturday. It may be cold, pack accordingly.
