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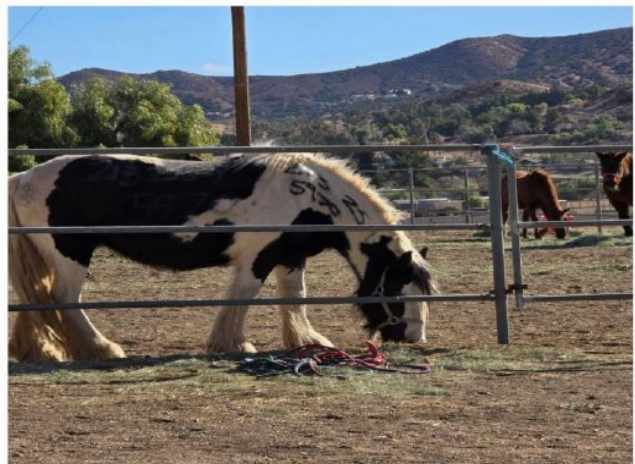
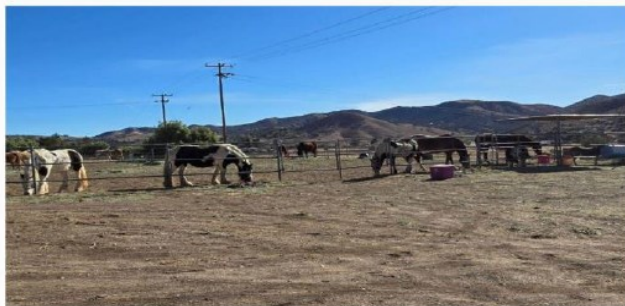

CORRAL NEWS

On January 22, 2025 during the devastation of the Hughes Fire in Castaic that decimated upward of 10,000 acres, some of our own Corral 22 members Sharon and Jason Ricardson were able to open their ranch to The Swan Center Outreach for evacuation. The Richardson's were made aware of their plight by Sharon's farrier Blanca Guzman, who is a dedicated volunteer at the Center. The Richardson's immediately jumped into action organizing, offering the use of their Ranch, and checking in with their neighbors the Swains', Tognazzini's, and the Wilkerson's to secure extra space and supplies that might be needed.

Fifteen horses and one very cute mini donkey with their supplies came in that Wednesday. They arrived by volunteer, the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Mounted Enforcement Detail and private vehicle convoy. It was incredible to see friends, neighbors, and law enforcement come together as a village to get these animals to safety and settled. Special thanks to their village of helpers including: Tyler Burzynski Transport, Jacob Deutsch Horse Trailers, Adam, Logan and Ashley Turner, David Cota, Jasmine Acajabon, Blanca Guzman, Mary Joya, Joie and Amy Einstein, Sue Haegele, George Sunna, the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Mounted Enforcement Detail, and The Swains'. We're sure we missed a few but we are grateful to them all!

A little about The Swan Center, it was established in 1987 and is run by Ashley Longhill and Pana Iliopoulos. They are a non-riding program dedicated to providing education and therapeutic programs to the community at large. Many of their horses have been rescued from backgrounds of neglect or being sold for slaughter, after which they are rehabilitated to serve as therapy animals. Bring manure carts, as both water and manure disposal are a bit of a jaunt. Limited corrals are first come first served. Tying to trailers, portable corrals and high lining are allowed. We will have a potluck dinner Saturday. It may be cold, pack accordingly.
